6. Attach a copy of a current school transcript.

Elective Requirements

1. Be a Member of the National Honor Society or Similar Honor Society/Fraternity.
Attach a copy of certificate or obtain a statement and the signature of the Teacher/Professor who oversees the Society/Fraternity.
2. Be named to the Honor Roll or Dean's List.
Attach Certificate or statement and signature of appropriate school official, or Newspaper Article.
3. Be acknowledged as student of the week/month/year.
Attach certificate or obtain statement and signature of appropriate school representative.
4. Have an ACT Composite Score of 22 or higher or an SAT total score of 1020 or higher.
Attach test score.
5. Have participated in a Study Abroad Program.
Attach appropriate documents to validate your study abroad experience.
6. Attend and complete a firearm training course.
Attach a copy of the certificate of completion or obtain statement and signature of Instructor.
7. Participate or serve as a volunteer at the Grand American
