MIKE JORDAN of Moro, Illinois was an avid trapshooter. He was inducted into the ATA Hall of fame in 2012, in 1985 he accomplished the ATA Grand Slam, AA-27-AA in 1985 and 1986. Mr. Jordan had 450,650 career ATA registered targets. In honor of his life and shooting career we are honored to award this scholarship to a student that shares his love of trap shooting.

2. Shoot at least 500 registered targets in the combined 2024 and 2025 target years. *Attach list of dates and locations.*

3. Attach an essay "How has Trapshooting motivated me."

4. Attach three letters of reference, which include one from your coach or another ATA Member and one from a teacher.

5. Must maintain a GPA of 2.5. Attach a current progress report from the High School displaying the GPA of the applicant.

This scholarship will be awarded at the 2025 AIM Grand Championships July 24 -28, 2025.
